FIRE REGULATIONS



ALWAYS use electrical appliances intended for food and drink preparation **only** in the kitchen



ALWAYS leave the building **immediately** when the fire alarm sounds



ALWAYS make sure all personal electrical equipment is **PAT tested**



NEVER tamper with or cover up heat and smoke detectors*



NEVER leave cooking unattended



NEVER use candles, incense sticks or any other naked flame in any part of the halls



NEVER block fire exit routes



NEVER smoke or use shisha pipes anywhere in halls or on the College campus



NEVER wedge open fire doors, keep them **shut**

If you are responsible for a fire alarm activation or, if you fail to evacuate when the alarm sounds, you will be charged £50 for each offence. Repeat offenders may be evicted

***Tampering with heat or smoke detectors is a criminal offence. Anyone found guilty of such an offence will be required to leave College accommodation, maybe suspended or expelled from Queen Mary, University of London, and could be liable to a fine levied by a criminal court and/or imprisonment.**
